



6oz. Nomex IIIA-Yellow

4" Alpine Collar can be worn folded down to allow venting or zipped up to completely cover neck providing additional protection from heat and flame. No throat strap and closure system required. Hanger loop at neck.

Seamless shoulders.

Double pull Zytel Delrin zipper with Nomex tape to be covered by storm-flap with hook/loop closures.

Radio pocket with hook/loop flap closure and microphone holder loop is set above pocket flap.

Cell phone pocket with hook and loop flap closure on right chest and d-ring at bottom for hanging gloves or gear.

Radial sleeve design and articulated elbows.

Adjustable cuffs with hook/loop closure, partially elasticized. ‘

Gusset at cuff shall have secondary hook/loop strip.

Large cargo hip pockets with hook/loop closures, with expansion for extra storage capacity and shall have built in hand warmer compartments. Right cargo pocket shall have a ¾" wide nickel-plated swivel snap hook attached to a 6" self-fabric strap. There shall be a snap hook sewn to inside of pocket. Strap allows to be pulled out for easy accessibility.

3M Scotchlite Flame Resistant Retro Reflective Lime/Yellow 2" Triple Trim sewn around arms bottom and across shoulders in back.

Corrosion-resistant brass snap at waist shall be fabric backed so no metal touches skin.

Zytel FR50 Delrin zipper with Nomex tape front fly closure is double needle lock stitched.

Welt style rear pockets with spade style flaps with color coordinated hook and loop closures.

Front slash style pockets have extra deep contoured pocket bags and spade style flaps with color coordinated hook and loop closures.

Zytel FR50 Delrin zippers with Nomex tape at side access lockstitched for easy access.

Over-sized mid-thigh cargo pockets with hook and loop flap closures expandable for extra storage.

Leg outseams and seat seams sewn with 5 thread safety stitch and then top stitched with double needle lockstitch.

Articulated knees.

Gusseted leg with multiple cuff closure system with 14" Zytel FR50 Delrin zippers with Nomex tape, elastic and hook/loop closure to adjust the take up. Partially elasticized cuffs.

3M Scotchlite Flame Resistant Retro Reflective Lime/Yellow 2" wide triple trim sewn around legs between knees and cuffs.
