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BID SPECIFICATIONS For Drug Testing Services

Drug Testing will be bid in two separate categories. Bidders are allowed to bid on both categories or a single category.

Category A will cover Pre-Employment Testing, Reasonable Suspicion/For Cause Testing, Post Accident Testing, Return to Duty Testing and Breath Alcohol Testing for all the same purposes. These tests will be administered at the Awarded Bidder's office.

Awarded Bidder will be required to accept walk-ins Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

Category B will cover Random Drug and Alcohol Testing. Awarded Bidder must be able to provide mobile services.
