Pumper-Apparatus Cab/Chassis:

Pumper-Apparatus will be a 2001 or newer

Pumper-Apparatus will be Red in color and 4-Door Cab

Pumper-Apparatus will have a *Cummins ISC 330 Engine* or equivalent and *Allison MD3060P Transmission* or equivalent

Approximate mileage of Pumper-Apparatus not to exceed 35,000 miles

Approximate hour-use of Pumper-Apparatus not to exceed 4,200 hours

Pumper-Apparatus will have Transmission Cooler; Air Conditioning; Heavy Duty Alternator; Manual Windows; AM/FM Radio

Pumper-Apparatus Body:

The body of Pumper-Apparatus will have a Maximum Length that will not exceed 29'4"
