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SPECIFICATIONS

200 Gallon Wildland Skid Unit

It is the intent of these specifications to clearly describe the furnishing and delivery to the Purchaser, a complete Skid Unit equipped as specified. The primary objective of these specifications is to obtain the most acceptable Skid Unit for service in the Fire Department. These specifications cover specific requirements as to the type of construction and tests the Skid Unit must conform, together with certain details as to finish, material preferences, equipment and appliances with which the successful bidder must conform to.

This skid must not exceed 50" wide and 80" long

TANK

Tank shall hold 200 gallons be constructed of polyethylene.

The tank shall have the features listed below:

- 1) Fill tower with removable screen located on the top of the tank.
- 2) 3" tank suction.
- 3) Liquid level sight gauge on left side of the tank.
- 4) 1" minimum refill fitting.
- 5) Vent and overflow pipe.
- 6) NFPA Baffles

FOAM TANK

12 Gallon integral foam tank shall be provided with the fill tower on the top of the tank. The foam cell must have a drain valve.

The tank shall have a lifetime warranty.

HOSE REEL

- (1) Hannay 1" hose reel with 100FT of 1" redline to be mounted on bed and may be mounted on either side that best fits our truck. (Or equivalent to)
- (1) Hannay 1/2 " hose reel with 200FT of ½ hose to be mounted on bed and may be mounted on either side that best fits our truck. (Or equivalent to)
- (2) Both hose reels will electric rewind.

PUMP and MOTOR

The pump shall be a Hale HPX100-B18 (or equivalent to) powered by 18HP Briggs and Stratton engine (or equivalent to) The fire pump shall be equipped with an electric starting system. With the items listed below:

- 1) Low oil pressure light
- 2) Electric start
- 3) Exhaust primer

The pump shall be located on the rear of the truck, mounted to the skid.

The fuel tank shall be DOT approved and supplied with the skid, plumped to the engine. Mounted for easy access for refueling.

PUMP PANEL and PLUMBING

The pump panel shall contain all the pump controls, shall be mounted at the rear of the apparatus attached to the skid. The panel shall be tilted to give operator direct view of controls.

All pressure valves shall be swing out quarter turn style. Each valve will have a knob and will be marked and color coded.

All plumbing will be stainless steel pipe or high pressure hose. Discharges will originate from a custom made manifold made from stainless pipe.

Pump must be plumbed for 2.5" rear intake to allow drafting operations.

All intake and discharges must have chrome fittings and chrome caps with chains.

PRE-CONNECT CROSSLAY

A 1 1/2" pre-connect crosslay shall be supplied and mounted to the top of the poly tank. With easy access.

FOAM SYSTEM

The foam system shall be a class A foam system.

The unit shall be plumbed in a manner that the foam will not enter the water tank.

The control panel will be located within easy reach of the operator.

ELECTRICAL

All wiring exposed to weather shall be installed with protective womb.

All hose reels shall be installed with manual circuit breakers and rewind switches.

LED work lights shall be installed by the pump panel area and any other work area.

WATER LEVEL INDICATOR

A FRC product LED light water level gauge shall be installed on the pump panel and in the cab of the truck.

PUMP TEST

The fire pump shall be tested after all of its associated piping and valves have been installed on the Skid Unit. The tests shall be conducted at the manufacturer's facility.

SERVICE

Each bidder shall supply, with their proposal, detailed information on the bidder's ability to perform routine and emergency service on the Skid Unit after delivery. They shall also provide all warranty information.

OTHER INORMATION

Unit must be installed on the Fire Department truck.

Each bid must be accompanied by a set of detailed specifications consisting of a detailed description of the Skid Unit and equipment proposed. All bid proposal specifications must be in the same sequence as the advertised specification for ease of comparison. These specifications shall include size, location, type, and model of all component parts being furnished. Detailed information shall be provided on the materials used to construct all facets of the Skid Unit body. Any bidder who fails to submit detailed construction specifications, or who photo copies and submits these specifications as their own construction details will be considered non-responsive and shall render their proposal ineligible for award.

Order to be paid with County Tax Funds.

Order must be complete no later than September 19th, 2013.

Purchase order will be acquired at the time of the bid awarding, but payment will not be made until all bid requirements have been meet and invoices turned into purchasing agent.
