

If all bids come in under the determined value of the vehicle, the board is required by law to re-bid.

Commissioners will re-advertise for bids and give no less than another 21 days from first day of advertising before bids are due.

Sealed bids will once again be opened during a meeting of the board of county commissioners.

This time the board of county commissioners will accept the highest bid regarding of amount offered.
