

**PITTSBURG COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
EMERGENCY MEETING
MINUTES
APRIL 27, 2015**

The Board of County Commissioners, Pittsburg County, met in emergency session on April 27, 2015 at 3:00 P.M., Meeting held in County Commissioners Conference Room, after proper notice and agenda were posted indicating time and date. Agenda was posted at 1:50 P.M., April 27, 2015.

1. COUNTY BUSINESS:

A. CONTACT WITH TRC DISASTER SOLUTION TO PROVIDE CLEANUP SERVICES FOR THE DAMAGES INCURRED DURING FLOODING ON APRIL 26, 2015: TRC stated that they have a crew on scene to extract the standing water and that right now the walls are wet 10" to 12" and that once the contents are removed that they will have to remove up to 4' of the walls and that it will take 4 to 5 days for it to dry. County Clerk Hope Trammell stated that she has spoken to the auditors about the damaged records. Cathy Thornton explained what the state election board requires. Selman asked where the records would be taken for drying. TRC explained the options. Smith suggested using the parking area for the storage containers. Smith made a motion to sign the contract with TRC and send the records that need to be dried to TRC facility; seconded by Rogers.
