#### **Abstract**

An evaluation of roof cuts from Pittsburg County Courthouse was conducted to determine if the proper coverage rate of LiquiTec was applied.

#### **Procedure**

LiquiTec's application guide specifies that over single ply, a system of 3 gal/sq of a base layer of LiquiTec followed by an embedded polyester scrim reinforcement, topped with 2 gal/sq of LiquiTec will be applied. In mils, an "ideal" LiquiTec system would have a top coat thickness of 32 mils before coming to the reinforcement and a total thickness of 80 mils.

Ten cores coming from various sections of Pittsburg County Courthouse were cut from the locations shown in Image 1





Image 1. Location of Core Cuts for Thickness Evaluation.

These were submitted to the laboratory in the form of 2" diameter specimens with the request to test thickness of LiquiTec. Each was carefully cut in half with a fresh utility blade. Along one cut edge, arbitrarily chosen from the two pieces, five equally spaced tick marks were made so that the profile looked like the example shown in Image 2.

Image 2. NOT THE SAMPLE -View through comparator of a typical cut profile showing the small black reference mark.



A hand held comparator with attached mil thickness scale was used to determine the thickness of the top layer, defined as the top of the coating to the top of the reinforcement, and also the total thickness of the entire coating system. Five thickness measurements were taken, one at each tick mark. The average of those measurements were calculated to determine average top coat and total thickness, which were then compared to the ideal top coat and total thickness. The data will be shown in the next section.

#### Results

Table 1 shows the average top coat and total thickness of each core relative to the ideal thickness for both with a +/- 10% variance.

#### Conclusions

The data conclusively shows that only one core (Core 8) had sufficient total coverage and more than adequate top coat coverage above the reinforcement. The remaining nine cores fell short by as much as 76% (Core 10) of the required top coat and total thickness. In some instances, the scrim could be clearly seen telegraphing its pattern through the top coat, indicating inadequate coverage.

#### RE: Pittsburgh County Courthouse - LiquiTec Restoration Inspection/Specification

Based on my inspection of the above referenced project last week and Garland lab evaluation of ten roof cores taken from the LiquiTec roof system restoration at the above referenced facility, the following is the scope of work to remediate and meet the specification requirements for warranty approval:

- Remove wet insulation as identified within the project Moisture Scan report and replace
- Cut single ply membrane on three sides and remove wet insulation and replace with new like kind and identical thickness. Clean back of single ply membrane to remove debris/insulation. Adhere back of cleaned old membrane to new insulation ensuring a smooth well-adhered membrane application. Apply Garland Unibond ST tape around cut perimeter edges of single ply membrane. Apply LiquiTec over Unibond Tape at 3 gal./sq (approximately 50 wet mils) and tie-in to existing cleaned and acetone-wiped LiquiTec
- Repair delaminated and wrinkled single ply flashing membrane on parapet walls per sections 3.2.A.2 and 3.3.B, g & h of specification to ensure a smooth substrate
- Grind down areas with any wrinkled Grip Polyester reinforcement with a Zek wheel. Clean and three course over area with new LiquiTec and Grip Polyester Reinforcement <a href="https://pantheonsurfaceprep.com/product/abrasive-wheels-coating-removal-tec-abrasive-disk-zec-wheel/">https://pantheonsurfaceprep.com/product/abrasive-wheels-coating-removal-tec-abrasive-disk-zec-wheel/</a>
- Ensure all flashings receive a fully reinforced Liquitec installation per specification
- Wall flashings were found to not receive reinforced LiquiTec per the specification
- Apply an additional 3.0 gal./sq.(approximately 50 wet mils) of LiquiTec to the field to account for application below the specified coverage rate of 5 gal./sq. total.
- The average thickness of the ten core samples was 2.31 gal./sq. or 37 mils, which is less than half of the 5 gal./sq. or 80 mils finished thickness specification requirement. Two roof core samples were as low as 19 and 21 mils total thickness, which equates to just over 1 gal./sq. In some areas, the Grip Polyester reinforcement is exposed which is indicative of lack of LiquiTec coverage.
- Power wash roof. Let dry and apply 100% acetone and immediately roll over the aged LiquiTec surface with a smooth roller to reactivate the surface prior to additional coating. Apply LiquiTec. Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns regarding the above scope of work to align with the specification requirements.


Core Sample #1 Overview-Confirmed Wet


Core Sample #4 Overview-Confirmed Wet

Application for road crossing must be submitted no later than 5 days before a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners with a check for the amount of permit made payable to the Pittsburg County Commissioners. The petitioner/contractor shall contact the County Commissioners Office at the completion of crossing for an onsite inspection.

 All crossings shall be bored on blacktop/asphalt roads. Cutting may be permitted on dirt roads, ditches, or other surfaces with approval from the Board of County Commissioners. Blasting is not permitted.

5. In construction pipelines or utility routes that cross county highways or roads, NO DITCH, TRENCH, OR BORING, shall be done by the applicant/contractor until approved by the Board of County Commissioners. All ditching and trenching shall be completed to the County Commissioner's specifications. Applicants, contractors or owners shall maintain crossing. (Signs, grass, brush control, etc.)

6. The petitioner/contractor shall furnish all flag men, lights, barricades, and warning signs meeting all laws and regulations, including those in the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices" appropriate for the construction project. The petitioner/contractor agrees to keep the road open to traffic unless approved by the Board of County Commissioners. At the conclusion of such work, the right-of-way must be in a presentable condition.

7. When notified to do so by the Board of County Commissioners, the petitioner/contractor agrees at their expense to make all changes in the facility on County right-of-way.

8. Relocation – Applicant, upon 30 days written notice, agrees to relocate utilities at their expense should it interfere with County construction and/or maintenance.

9. Aerial facilities – Clearance above the traffic lanes of the road at all aerial pole line crossings shall comply with applicable safety codes and will not be less than 20 feet. All poles, posts, stubs, fixtures, down guys, wires, and other appurtenances must be kept in good repair at all times and free from weeds and brush within a 5-foot area of the installation. These facilities, when paralleling the roadway, shall be single pole construction and located within 3 feet of the fence line, if a fence exists. If no fence exists, the right-of-way shall be located by an Oklahoma Registered Land Surveyor at the petitioner's expense and a copy provided to the Board prior to construction. All crossings shall be as nearly perpendicular as possible. Facility shall not interfere with the natural flow of waters or ditch.

10. Underground facilities – All shall be a minimum of 5 feet below the elevation of the center line of the road, but not less than 4 feet fellow the bottom of the ditch. Crossings shall be encased from right-of-way line to right-of-way line and be vented off the right-of-way lines. Concrete caps of 4' wide and 6" deep may be required from edge of road to fence line. Identification markers shall be installed at each right-of-way line directly above the facility. The markers must identify the owner's name, address and telephone

number, size of facility, and emergency contact number in black with a yellow background. Marker must be at least 130 sq. inches in area and erected at a height plainly visible from the road right-of-way.

All underground electric cable crossings must be placed in a conduit and be a minimum of 4 feet below the ditch flow lines. Conduit placed beneath a roadway must be steel, HDPE, heavy-duty PVC, or fiberglass if it is designed to withstand roadway loading and is properly protected.

Steel pipelines crossing the right-of-way may be, upon approve of the Commissioner, installed without encasement if the carrier pipe material within the right-of-way is superior to the carrier pipe material outside the right-of-way by being of steel at least one grade better and of the same wall thickness, or a minimum of one wall thickness greater and of the same alloy. Pipe must be properly protected from corrosion.

Facilities such as water and sanitary sewer lines crossing the county right-of-way shall be encased. Maintenance will be performed by a method that will not disturb the through lanes or interfere with traffic. All conduits shall be sufficient to withstand roadway loadings.

11. All section corners and ¼ section corners shall be protected. No pipeline or utility line shall cross an intersection diagonally. No liens shall cross within 50 feet of a ¼ section corner or 100' of a bridge.

Trenched lines shall be at sufficient depth as to not interfere with normal maintenance and shall be removed at applicant's expense. The owner, firm or company requesting the permit for temporary or permanent line(s) shall be responsible for all damages to county roads or right-of-way caused by such installation. Temporary installation permits are for a period of thirty (30) days. A new permit will be required for each thirty (30) day time period.
