**6. BOARD BUSINESS:**

**A. REVIEW FINANCIALS AND REPORTS CONCERNING 911 REVENUES:** Rogers asked about the October expenses. Tara Roberts explained that the 911 cannot completely fund itself. Sherri Swift stated that the City subsidizes 911 annually in the amount of \$297,000.00.

**B. REPORT FROM 911 DIRECTOR:** Roberts presented the 911 directors report. Roberts explained the 911 statistics report for October. Jeff Daniels asked about police calls. Daniels asked if 911 bills McAlester Police for its services.

Daniels explained that centralized 911's bill each department for their services. Roberts stated they would have to bill out all towns and fire departments to make it fair. McClendon explained that the Sheriff's Office bills for dispatch services to the cities that they are dispatch for. Daniels asked about 911 state fees collections. Roberts stated that 911 fees are paid to the state and the state pays the P-sap.

**D. GENERAL DISCUSSION (NO ACTION):** Frankie McClendon asked about medical calls and the Sheriff not being notified for ambulance calls outside of the city limits and gave examples. Jeff Daniels asked about buildings inside the city limits with the name of Pittsburg County McAlester PD is not responding. Roberts stated that response should go but where the crime occurs. Swift asked who determines who responds. Roberts stated that dispatch determines who to notify. McClendon asked if 911 stays on the line when they transfer calls. Roberts stated that they should if they can.
