IF GRANTED, THIS PERMIT IS SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS, REQUIREMENTS, AND COVENANTS, TO-WIT:

- 1. Application for road crossings must be submitted to the COUNTY COMMISSIONERS no later than FIVE (5) DAYS before a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners with a check for \$500.00 (per line) made payable to PITTSBURG COUNTY. (Please identify the District # on the check). Applicant/Contractor must telephone County Commissioners' office twenty-four (24) hours prior to actual construction so an inspector can be at the site during construction.
- 2. In construction pipelines or utility routes that cross county highways or roads, NO DITCH, TRENCH, OR BORING shall be done by the applicant/contractor until approved by the Board of County Commissioners. All ditching and trenching shall be completed to the County Commissioner's specifications. Applicants, contractors or owners shall maintain crossing. (signs, grass, brush control, etc.)
- 3. When paralleling the roadway, utility lines shall be located within four (4) feet of the R/W line or the fence line, if a fence is in place. If no fence exists, the R/W line shall be located by an Oklahoma Registered Land Surveyor at the applicant's expense. A copy of said survey shall be provided to the Board of County Commissioners prior to granting a permit. In no instance shall a utility be placed within the limits of the roadbed. All underground parallel installations shall be a minimum of thirty (30) inches deep, except power which should be placed a minimum depth of forty-eight (48) inches below the surface. All overhead parallel installations shall not cross any point of access to the county road at a height of less than eighteen (18) feet.
- 4. All Section corners and ¼ Section Corners shall be protected. No pipeline or utility line shall cross an intersection diagonally, and no lines shall cross within fifty (50) feet of a ¼ Section Corner.
- 5. The applicant agrees to keep the road open to traffic unless otherwise agreed to or approved by the Board of County Commissioners.
- 6. Applicant, contractor, well owner or pipeline owner will move or lower at their expense said utility or pipeline, if and when it interferes with highway construction or maintenance, upon notice from the Board of County Commissioners.
- 7. All underground crossings shall be a minimum of four (4) feet below the elevation of the centerline of the road or two (2) feet below the elevation of the ditch, whichever is greater. High pressure gas line crossings shall be a minimum of four (4) feet below the elevation of the ditch.
- 8. Applicant agrees that pipe shall be sleeved (cased), preferable in steel, at each road crossing.

- 9. Applicant agrees to erect any overhead lines to the clearance height and other rules of construction, as prescribed by the Corporation Commission of the State of Oklahoma
- 10. The applicant/contractor agrees that if PITTSBURG COUNTY is owed any funds by the applicant, contractor, well owner, or pipeline owner that this permit will not be approved until all indebtedness has been paid in full.
- 11. Applicant/contractor is aware that all road crossing permits for PITTSBURG COUNTY shall require approval from the Pittsburg County Floodplain Administrator and that all permits and fees owed to the Floodplain Administrator will be paid in full before approval is given by the Board of County Commissioners.
- 12. Applicant agrees to hold free and blameless this County for any damages to persons or property caused by construction or maintenance of any poles, posts, stubs, pipes, valves, wires, and other property placed on or under said highway.
