

IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW COURTHOUSE SECURITY MEASURES

Beginning in mid-April, the Board of County Commissioners and the Pittsburg County Sheriff will implement the use of metal detectors and package scanners at the Pittsburg County Courthouse. With these changes the Board and Sheriff hope to ensure a safer environment at the courthouse and ease any discomfort that may be felt while visiting our courthouse.

Also, please be advised that pets are not allowed at the Pittsburg County Courthouse though service dogs are welcome. Pittsburg County makes every effort to adhere to the Americans with Disabilities Act and the Oklahoma State Statutes regarding service animals. Therapy animals will only be allowed admission with written approval of our district judge, the associate district judge or one of our special judges.
